INTERNAL REGULATIONS - CAMPING LOS NARANJOS

1. User and Visitor Registration

All users must register at reception before using any of the campsite's facilities.

Visitors must also check in at reception and pay the current applicable fee. If not, the cost will be charged to the host camper.

2. Pets

Pets must always be kept on a leash, under the full control and responsibility of their owners. They must be taken outside the campsite to relieve themselves, always leashed.

3. Waste Management

Organic waste, plastic, glass, cardboard, etc. must be disposed of in the containers located near the main entrance and emergency exit.

4. Responsibility for Personal Belongings

The management is not responsible for theft, loss, or damage to users' personal belongings.

5. Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are from 12:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. During this time, users must respect others' rest by avoiding noise and keeping the volume low on radios, televisions, and other devices.

6. Internal Traffic Rules

The vehicle entry/exit barrier will remain closed from 12:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.

Maximum speed inside the campsite is 10 km/h. Vehicle movement during quiet hours is prohibited unless strictly necessary.

7. Water Supply

Drinking water is connected to the Moncofa municipal system. Please use it responsibly and rationally.

8. Check-Out Time

Check-out must be completed before 12:00 p.m. After that time, an additional day will be charged.

9. Use of Fire

Lighting fires with wood or charcoal is strictly prohibited outside of designated areas.

10. Plot Changes

Any change of pitch must be previously authorized by the management.

Payment for the stay may be requested at any time.

11. Use of Trees and Natural Structures

It is strictly forbidden to tie ropes, hang objects, or use trees as support for any purpose.

12. Regulation Updates

The management reserves the right to modify, extend or restrict these rules and to take necessary measures in case of non-compliance.

We appreciate your cooperation, respect for the rules, and commitment to peaceful coexistence and proper use of the facilities.
